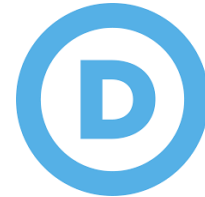

Sunday, June 19, 2016 is Father's Day. Have a moment of silence to your heavenly father for these victims in Charleston and Orlando!

The anniversary of the massacre at Mother Emanuel is on June 17th, and the church is planning events for 12 days to remember the nine lives lost and continue the healing.

The series of events called "Victory in the Valley" starts on Wednesday, June 15th with a Bible study.

The victims are:

The Rev. Clementa Pinckney, 41: A state senator and [the senior pastor of Emanuel](#), he was married to Jennifer Benjamin and the father of two children, Eliana and Malana.

Cynthia Hurd, 54: According to the Charleston County Public Library, she was a 31-year employee who managed the John L. Dart Library for 21 years before heading the St. Andrews Regional Library

The Rev. Sharonda Coleman-Singleton, 45: A pastor at Emanuel, she was also a speech therapist and high school girls track and field coach, both positions at Goose Creek High School, [according to her LinkedIn page](#).

Tywanza Sanders, 26: He was a 2014 graduate in business administration from Allen University in Columbia.

Ethel Lance, 70: She had attended Emanuel for most of her life and worked there as a custodian

Susie Jackson, 87: Lance's cousin, she was a longtime church member.

Depayne Middleton Doctor, 49: The mother of four sang in Emanuel's choir. region."
